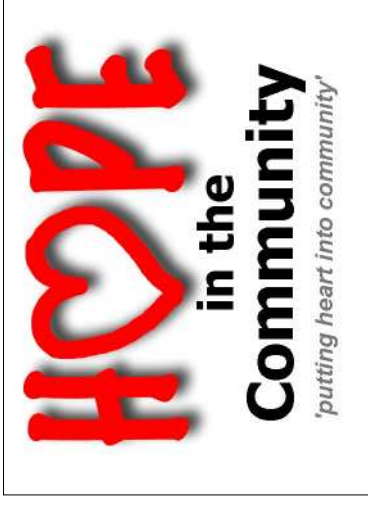

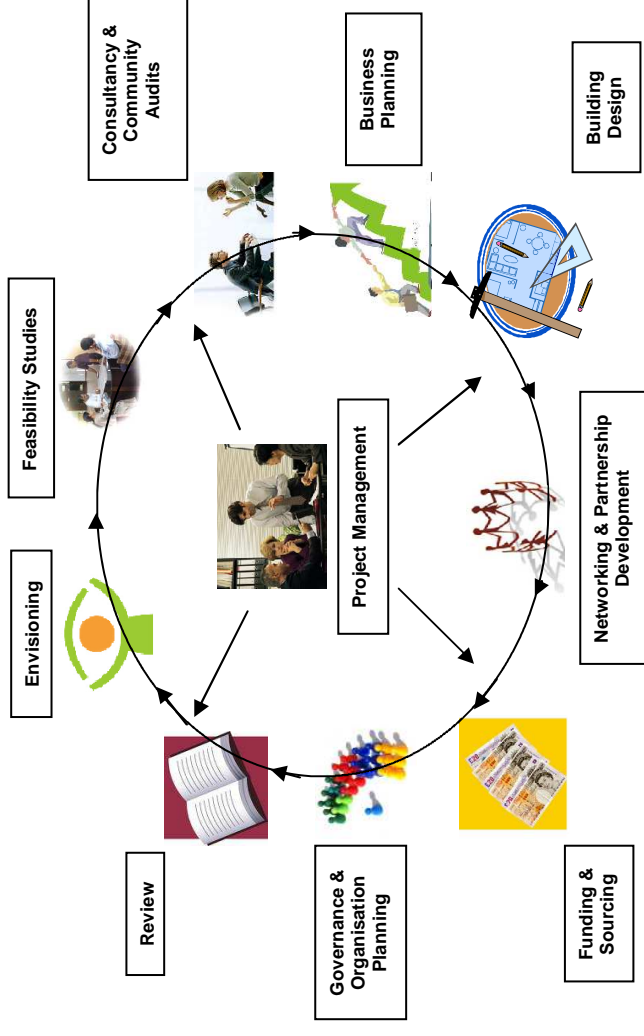

Sample Projects



HitC supported the development of a £1.5m **Community Enterprise Hub** based at a church in Sheerness.

Ongoing support is being provided by HitC following a £60K development project to provide for a **UKonline, Library and Community Facility** at a chapel on the Isle of Grain.
